The society watches over the professional ethics of its members and stands up in front of national problems regarding biology, chemistry and all other disciplines connected to them and more generally regarding biomedical sciences



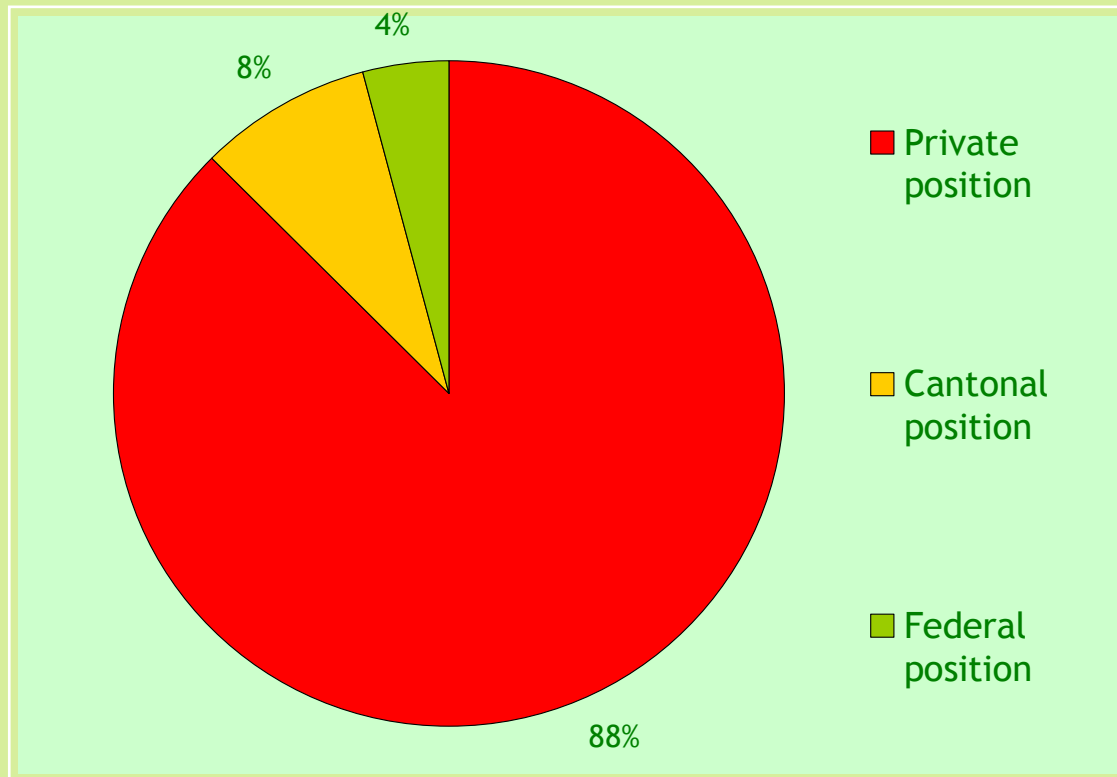
Statistics

- Average age 41 (ATC 2002).

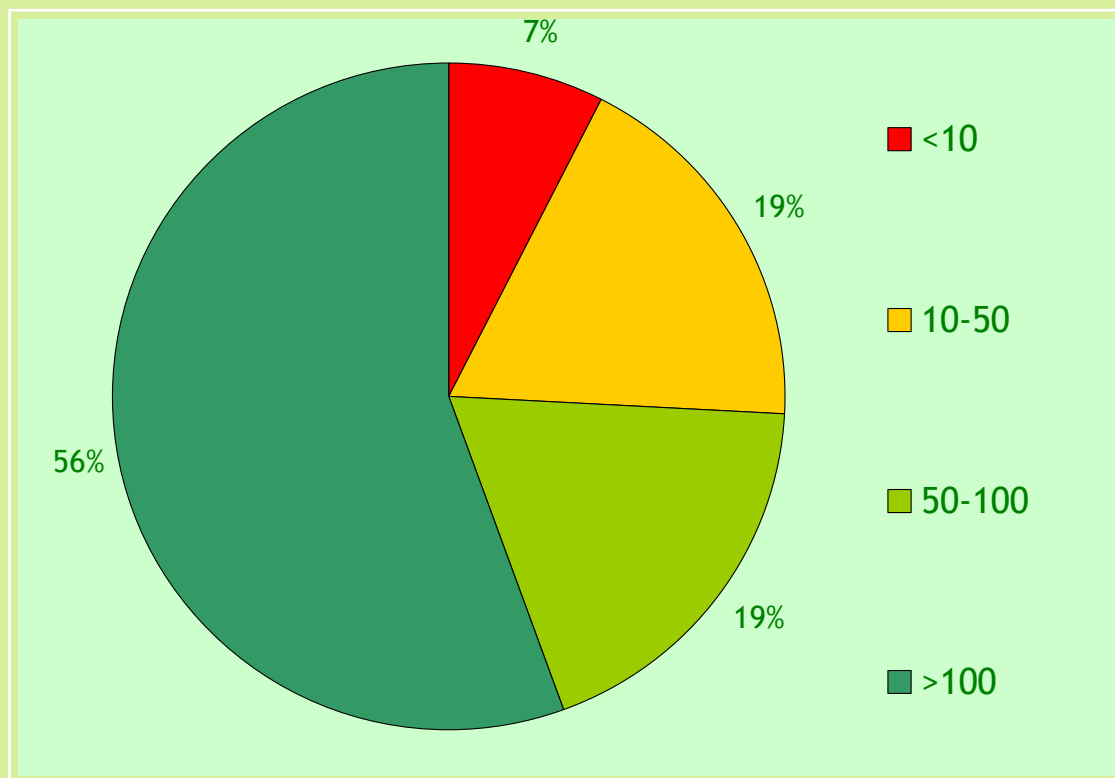


Nature of position (ATC 2002)



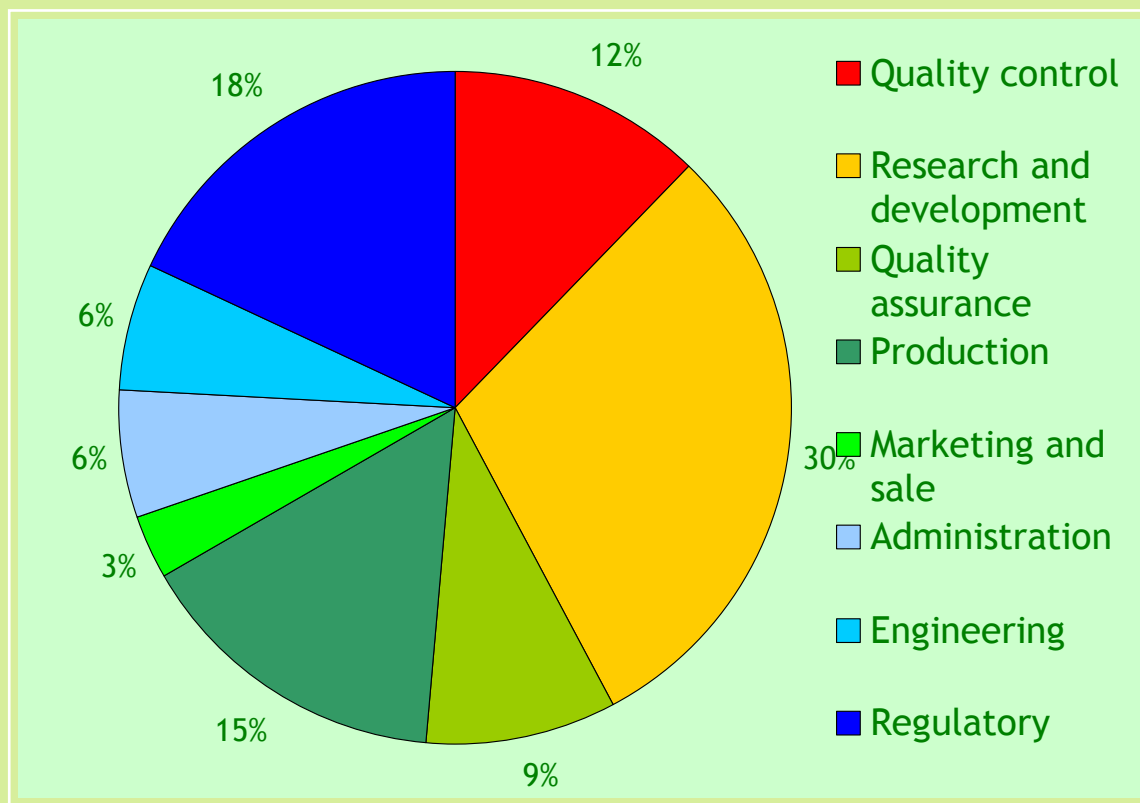


Size of companies where members worked at (ATC 2002)
